Intensive Program participants violating these rules will be reprimanded or even expelled from the course without a refund, at the discretion of the school management.

Violations or Harassment includes, but not limited to:

- Inappropriate verbal comments that reinforce social structures of domination or discrimination related to gender, race, religion, age, gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, national origin or citizenship status
- Inappropriate images, comments, jokes or videos in public spaces
- Deliberate intimidation or stalking
- Hurtful speech
- Sustained disruption of talks, student questions or other events
- Inappropriate physical contact
- Unwanted condescending or patronizing explanation, "Mansplaining"
- Unwelcome sexual attention
- Lying, cheating, plagiarism or dishonesty of any kind
- Thief of materials, tools or school or other student's property
- Advocating for, or encouraging, any of the above behaviour

Violating School Rules include, but not limited to:

- Smoking on premise
- Consumption of alcohol during class hours
- Safety guidelines deliberately not followed
- Missing 20% or more of class instruction
- Not maintaining the minimum requirements of class
- Not meeting financial requirements of course
- Deliberate destruction of property or tools

Enforcement

Expulsion will be used in extreme cases of sexual harassment or hateful speech. Students will be warned at which time the inappropriate behaviour must stop immediately. Students will only receive one warning. Further violations will be addressed on a case by case basis by school management.
